#### 1. Classical Dance - Solo

- a. Provides only Facial makeup on prior intimation to coordinator on or before 04-12-2023.
- b. Costumes, Jewellery and Special dance articles to be brought by participants.
- c. Time 3 4 minutes only.
- d. Bring pen drive with one dance song.
- e. Judges decision is final.

#### 2. Folk Dance - Group

- a. Time 3 4 minutes only.
- b. 2-5 participants only.
- c. Provides only Facial makeup on prior intimation to coordinator on or before 04-12-2023.
- d. No indecent or vulgar songs may be chosen.
- e. Bring one pen drive with one dance song.
- f. Makeup description for each role may be given to coordinator before 04-12-2023, dance articles to be brought by participants.
- g. Folk song may be taken from movies or other private albums in Telugu or any other language.
- h. Judges decision is final.

### 3. Telugu Poetry - Writing - Solo

- a. White papers will be supplied by college.
- b. Time allotted only 45 minutes.
- c. A participant must write atleast 15 lines.
- d. Message, meaning, poetry, language is the criteria.
- e. Prize winners will be asked to present their poems at the prize giving ceremony.
- f. Judges decision is final.

#### 4. Floor Crossing -

- a. There are two teams, each consisting of two speakers.
- b. Each team has two or three constructive speeches, and two to three rebuttal speeches. The affirmative gives the first constructive speech, and the rebuttals alternate: negative, affirmative, negative, affirmative has both the first and last speeches of the debate.
- c. The affirmative must advocate everything required by the topic itself. No revision of position of a team is permitted during the debate.
- d. He who asserts must prove. In order to establish an assertion, the team must support it with enough evidence and logic to convince an intelligent but previously uninformed person that is is more reasonable to believe the assertion than to disbelieve it. Facts must be accurate.
- e. Discipline is of prime importance.
- f. The time limit will be 5 minutes for each team.
- g. The judge's decisions will be final.

#### 5. Modern Dance: Group

- a. Time 3 4 minutes only.
- b. 2-5 participants only.
- c. Provides Only Facial makeup on prior intimation to coordinator on or before 04-12-2023.
- d. No indecent or vulgar songs may be chosen.
- e. Dresses, dance articles or any other items may be brought participants.
- f. Judges decision is final.

#### 6. English Poetry – Writing - Solo

- a. Participant shall write in 45 minutes a poem of at least 14 lines on any one of the five themes announced at 10.15am.
- b. The poem may be any form (i.e. sonnet, free verse, etc.).
- c. Creativity/originality, relevance to the theme, and structure is criteria.
- d. Participant to report by 9.30am at venue, can use dictionary.
- e. Prize winners will be asked to present their poems at the prize giving ceremony.

#### 7. English Poetry – Reading - Solo

- a. Participant shall read out any poem of his/her choice for not more than 4 min. and not less then 2 min.
- b. Prize winners will be asked to present their poems at the prize giving ceremony.

Note: Billy Collins's advice ('How to read a poem out loud'), on Pg. 4 may help.

#### 8. Telugu poetry – Reading - Solo

- a. Theme will be kept in college web site by 04-12-2023.
- b. Participants have to collect poetry from old or new writers in Telugu literature, or written by himself or herself has to readout in allotted time.
- c. Participant has to read out atleast 20 lines of Telugu poetry
- d. Time allotted only 4 minutes.
- e. Only Telugu language allowed.
- f. Vocabulary, poetry, meaning, pronunciation, Message, is the criteria.
- Judges decision is final.
