Rules and Regulations

- 1. Only a Bonafide, regular student who is enrolled for a course of the University which is of a maximum duration of Six years and whose examinations is conducted by the University shall be eligible to participate in the event. The detained and discontinued students are not eligible to participate in this tournament.
- 2. Not more than 5 years after passing 10+2 examination or equivalent examination while pursuing Graduate Courses/Studies is accepted.
- 3. All the participants should bring their college Identity Card and Aadhar card as proofs.
- 4. All the participants should bring No Objection Certificate (Bonafide) from the Director/the Principal of the college concerned.
- 5. Only one team from a college will be allowed to participate in a particular game.
- 6. Participants of all the events should report at the assigned venue at least 30 minutes before the respective events.
- 7. If any participant is involved in any in disciplinary activities he/she will be eliminated from the tournament immediately.
- 8. Illegal participation of any player/Team in any event will be responsible for disqualification of all teams of the concerned college from all events of the tournament and the college authority will be responsible for this act.
- 9. Decision of the judges/empires will be final and must be binding to all. Once the decision is given, no player is encouraged for further arguments.
- 10. Players must come in proper dress code during the tournament.
- 11. Participants will be provided with complimentary food and accommodation.
- 12. If a team does not qualify for the next level, they have to leave the campus immediately.
- 13. A Refundable Caution Deposit should be paid at the time of registration (Physical), which is refunded before they leave.
- 14. Every team must submit a xerox copy of a Bonafide certificate at the time of registration and carry a copy with the team.
- 15. Maximum 3 members (Coaches/managers/PD's) are allowed from each college along with the team.
- 16. MBA or MTech students are also eligible if only they are part of any engineering college.
- 17. To the extent possible avoid common players.

Note:

- 1. Referee decision is final.
- 2. All the matches are on knock out basis.
- 3. Every team should report 10 mins before the match.
- 4. Matches shall be conducted as per "Federation Rules".
- 5. Each team consists of 12 players for Basketball, Volleyball & Kabaddi.
- 6. Mat Shoes are compulsory for all the players of Kabaddi.
- 7. Mach team consists of 15 players for Kho-Kho.
- 8. Entry Fee for the team events: Basketball, Volleyball, Kho-Kho & Kabaddi is 1000/- per team
- 9. Entry Fee for the Individual events: Tennis & Table tennis is 500/- per team.
- 10. One team for doubles and two singles per college is permitted for Tennis.
- 11. One team of 5 players per college is permitted for Table tennis.
- 12. Rope Skipping events:

(Individual events)

- 1. Single bounce (1min)
- 2. Speed sprint (cycling)

(Team Events)

1. Speed relay (4X30sec)

- 2. Double Dutch relay (4X45sec)
- 13. Entry Fee for the Individual Rope Skipping is 300/-
- 14. Entry Fee for the Team Rope Skipping is 500/-
- 15. Bring your own skipping ropes for the event.
- 16. Athletics:

Events (Men and Women)

- 1. 100 mts Run
- 2. 400 mts Run
- 3. 1500 mts
- 4. Long Jump
- 5. Triple Jump
- 6. Shot put
- 7. Discus Throw
- 8. (4X100) mts Relay

For all the above events only.

- A. Only 2 participants can participate in each event from the same college.
- B. Each Athlete can participate only in three events (i.e., I track event and 2 field events and vice versa).
- C. Entry fee for each Athlete is 300/- (An athlete can participate in any of the 3 events).
