25.03	<p>The Chairman of IQAC presented the efforts OF alumni in establishing Skill Oriented Programming Lab and highlighted his ideas to establish Innovation Center, whose objective is translate novel ideas of students in to physical reality with support of alumni.</p> <p>It is resolved to establish skilling centres and specialized courses with the support of alumni.</p>	Invitation was sent to alumni members regarding support for establishment of skilling centres. First response was from the alumni of Mechanical engineering department. He came forward to supply machine vision software worth 5 lakhs for free of cost.
